WHAT IS WOOD BADGE?

Wood Badge training was started by Lord Baden Powell in 1919 to ensure that the leaders of Scout troops were properly trained. Since then Wood Badge has been held worldwide, providing advanced leadership training to thousands of Scout leaders.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Wood Badge is designed to meet the advanced leadership needs of **ALL** adult leaders across all programs, including Cubs, Scouts BSA, Venturing, and Sea Scouts. No leader is ever considered "too inexperienced" to complete Wood Badge. Any Scouter serving at the Unit, District, or Council level can achieve greater effectiveness through Wood Badge!

The program for the first weekend begins Friday morning at 7:30 AM and concludes Sunday afternoon by 4:30 PM; the second weekend begins Saturday morning at 7:30 AM and concludes Sunday afternoon by 4:30 PM.

Early Bird Course fee \$225 thru January 31, 2024

Regular course fee \$250 January 31-April 4, 2024

Registration after 3/31/24 requires Course Director pre-approval to verify available space.
