General Requirements

Sabattis offers a Counselor in Training (CIT) program for Scouts who will be 14 years of age by the start of staff week. Applicants must be registered in Scouts BSA, an Explorer Post, or Venture Crew.

During your session as a CIT, you will experience assignments in areas of camp operation of your interest. Preference in selecting camp staff for future years will be determined by successful completion of your training and the CIT experience.

As a CIT you will stay and eat meals with your unit in their campsite. You will function as a staff member during the program day.

As you consider this opportunity, you and your parents should be aware that your pay would be the training you receive.

As a CIT you will always follow the rules and regulations of the camp. These rules and regulations are defined in the staff manual that you will receive. You will be treated as a staff member, as you will be a staff member; all expectations and privileges as go along with such positioning and responsibility as an agent of the Boy Scouts of America.

**** Your unit must be attending Sabattis Scout Reservation for at least one week for you to join staff as a CIT. You would arrive and return home with your unit. There are no fees for attending Sabattis Scout Reservation as a CIT.****
