1800 Trail		A hiking trail along the north shore of Three Point Pond and following the 1800 foot contour line.
A Scout is Reverent	Patch Program	An award earned in-camp by a unit (or patrol) by following a list of requirements and marked by a special patch.
Abenaki's Edge Program	Area/Activity	Program for older campers offering wilderness adventures and activities. Non-merit badge focused, but selected merit badges are taught along with the activities.
Action Archery	Activity	An optional activity during open shoots using moving targets (machine-launched foam disks using special arrows).
Archery	Area	Located on trail from Scoutcraft Area. Archery MB and open shoots.
Area Director	Staff Member	A senior staff member in charge of a program area (e.g. Aquatics, Scoutcraft, Nature, Rifle, etc.)
BBQ Area	Area	Open area in front of Handicraft (including the Handicraft pavilion) with picnic tables. Used for campwide assembly and opening/closing campwide meals.
Bear Crossing	Location	Picnic or camping destination east of camp on the southern shore of Lows Lake (hike, bike, or paddle). Near the eastern boundary of camp property. A rocker location.
Bear Point	Location	Picnic or camping destination east of camp on the southern shore of Lows Lake (hike, bike, or paddle). Very close to trip center. A rocker location.
Billing Conference	Term	Meeting held during the camp session between the Camp Director and Unit Leaders to settle out final camp fees.
BMI-Restrictions	Term, Map	Per BSA and Department of Health requirements, defines acceptable camp areas and activities accessible to campers not meeting the BSA height/weight requirement.
Bog Lake	Location	Paddle destination southwest of camp located off the southern boundary of Lows Lake. A rocker location.
Bog Trail	Term/Location	A short hiking loop located at the Nature center highlighting local plants and wildlife.
Boone's Landing	Location	Camping destination located southwest of camp on the southern shore of Bog Lake (paddle). A rocker location.

Canoe & Carry	Activity	In-camp activity comprising a canoe trip between the Outing (Trip) Center and Hornets Pond including all four bodies of water in the main camp and three short portages. A rocker location.
Challenge Valley	Evening Group Activity	An obstacle course-like facility and event offered as an evening activity. Mostly a competition to see who can get muddiest.
Chapel	Location	Non-demoninational outdoor facility used for weekly services and also available to Units and campers for their individual use. Located on main road just before trail to Rifle and Nature.
CIT	Staff Member	Counselor-In -Training. Unpaid staff position offering introduction to staff activities and duties. Usually a lead-in to a paid position the following year.
Closing Campfire Ring	Location	the road leading from the waterfront. Used for closing campfires and other special events.
Commissary	Area, Section of Staff	Food and food-related supplies ordering, stocking, and distribution. Supplies food to the staff kitchen and food buckets to patrols in camp, and food for out-of-camp outings.
Commissary Drop/Commissioner Areas	Location/Facility	One of three locations where food is delivered for patrol pickup and where garbage may be dropped off. Also the Unit reporting point for emergency drills and camp emergencies.
Commissioner	Staff Member	Liason between camp staff and campers - Provides guidance to units in camp, facilitates issue resolution, and two-way communication between campers and appropriate staff.
Cowboy Action	Activity & Area, Evening	Non-merit badge shooting sports activity.
Duke Rock	Location	Hiking destination in the northeast camp property. Short, relatively easy hike. A rocker location.
Family Camp	Area	Satellite camping area located just outside Main Entrance. Includes recreation hall and bathhouse facility. Typically used for transient visitors and other overflow housing.
Family Camp Beach	Area	Open area on north shore of Big Hornets pond. Located just past (east of) BBQ Area. Good fishing access.

Frying Pan Island	Location	Camping or picnic destination on Lows Lake Exclusive access during camp season. Paddle only. A rocker location.
Gooseneck Island	Location	Camping or picnic destination on Lows Lake Exclusive access during camp season. Paddle only. A rocker location.
Grass Pond	Location	Located west of camp off the north boundary Bog Lake (hike or paddle). A rocker location.
Grass Pond Mountain	Location	Hiking destination west of camp on the north side of Lows Lake. A rocker location.
Graves Mountain	Location	Hiking destination west of camp. Trailhead is on camp property but the mountain off-property and is available through permission of owners. Dramatic sweeping views of Bog River flow (Lows Lake). Hike or bike. A rocker location.
Handicraft	Area, Phasing out	Program area for merit badges associated with artistic and manual skills.
Health Lodge	Location/Facility	HQ for camp Health Officer and staff. Located across the main road from the Main Res. Building
Hitchen's Pond	Location	Located three miles west of camp below the upper dam and above the lower dam. (hike, bike, or paddle). A rocker location.
Horseshoe Lake	Location	Located east of camp past Hitchens Pond (hike, bike, or paddle). A rocker location.
Junior Staff	Staff Member	Staff members under the age of 18.
Ice Caves	Location	Hiking destination west of camp on the north side of Lows Lake and on the eastern shore of Grass Pond. Caves formed by large erratics holds ice and packed snow from the previous winter well into the summer season (hike, bike, or paddle). A rocker location.
Key Log/Log Rolling	Activity, Area	Water Olympics (or at other selected times) event.
Lookout Mountain	Location	Hiking destination in the northeast camp property. Short, relatively easy hike. A rocker location.
Lookout Point	Location	Camping or picnic destination west of camp on the southern shore of Lows lake and on camp property. Dramatic views of Lows Lake (hike, bike, or paddle). A rocker location.

(Lottery) Activity Selection	Term	Monday morning session held in the Staff Center in which units select various camp activities and trips in which to participate during the week.
Lows Lake	Location	Artificial Lake formed by the upper dam and comprising the southern border of the camp property. Provides access to the five ponds wilderness and beyond.
Lows Ridge	Location	Hiking destination located three miles west of camp with the trailhead adjacent the upper dam (hike, bike, or paddle). Sweeping views of Lows Lake and Bog River flow. A rocker location.
LZ, Landing Zone	Area	Assembly area in center of camp. Next to Challenge Valley and is the site for Woodsman's Games and other camp activities needing open space.
Main Entrance	Location	Main entrance gate in front of the Main Res. Called the "Main Entrance" even though it is one mile inside camp property.
Main "Res"	Location/Facility	Administrative offices for camp. Also includes Commissary and Ranger's Shop.
Moose Bay	Location	Camping destination located southwest of camp on the southern shore of Bog Lake (past Boone's Landing). A rocker location.
Mountain Bike Shed	Area	Located between Trading Post and New Shower House. Mountain Bike program area, storage, and maintenance shop.
Nature (George R. Schmid Nature Center)	Area	the Bog Trail and rowboat access to Lows Lake. Located off the main road past the Rifle area.
New Showerhouse	Area	Located between Trading Post and main road. Includes male and female adult facilities and youth showers.
Old Showerhouse	Area	Located between the LZ and Three Pound Pond. Includes male and female adult facilities and youth showers.
Opening Campfire Ring	Location	Located on Three Pound Pond between Deer Run and Tanglebush Unit sites. Used for opening campfires and other special events.

Outing Center (Trip Center)	Beach area on Lows Lake	Launching point for outings and trips on Lows Lake. Includes canoe storage, sailboats, paddleboards, and related equipment storage.
Patrol Cooking	Term	Food is distributed three times a day to Scout patrols who then cook all their own meals.
Pole Island	Location	Camping or picnic destination on Lows Lake Exclusive access during camp season. Paddle only. A rocker location.
Program Area	Term	Any camp facility providing activities for campers.
Ranger's Program	Patch Program	A staged year-by year program emphasizing service to the camp with each stage marked by a patch which is part of a set.
Ranger's Shop	Location/Facility	Located in Main Res. Primary shop and maintenance facility for the camp.
Resident Camp	Term	A camp session where campers stay overnight (as opposed to Day Camp where they come in and out each day, not staying overnight).
Rifle	Area	Rifle MB area including standard 50 foot .22 caliber range and Cowboy Action range. Located between main road and Nature.
Rockers, ie. Rocker Quest	Trip Options, Activities, Trek	Part of "Abenaki Edge" program for older campers. Select locations in and around camp have "rocker" style patches associated with them which are earned by visiting the location.
Scoutcraft	Activity & Area	Program area for merit badges associated with Scout skills.
Scoutmaster's Lounge	Location/Facility	Located back of the Trading Post. General meeting area for Unit Leaders for use at their convenience. Also the location for bi-weekly SPL meetings.
Senior Staff	Staff Member	Staff members ages 18 and over. All Area Directors are Senior Staff.
Service Areas	Term	Any camp facility providing camp services (but not camper activity). Includes Administration, Maintenance (Ranger staff), Food Services (Commissary), Trading Post, Health Lodge, and Commissioners.

Seton Trek Center, STC, Marmaduke Trek Center	Trek Headquarters at Sabattis	Staging point for Sabattis Treks. Includes equipment storage and planning facilities and resources.
Shotgun Area	Area	Program area teaching the Shotgun MB. Located on road to Outing (Trip) center close to the Trek Center.
Sink the Scoutmaster	Activity	Water Olympics event.
(Senior Patrol Leader) SPL Meetings	Activity	Meetings held each Monday and Wednesday evening in the Scoutmaster's Lounge between camp staff (typically Program Director, Head Commissioner, and Camp Director) and campers. Monday meeting focused mostly on communicating Camp information and procedures to campers. Wednesday meetings focused mostly on feedback from campers to staff.
Spring Pond Rock		Natural climbing rock west of camp to the north of the main road. Rock Climbing MB area (when offered).
Staff Center	Area	Meeting and dining hall including kitchen on main road into camp. Location for staff functions and also leader's meetings. Also includes staff bathroom, shower, and laundry facilities.
Staff Row		Staff housing area in the area of the Staff Center. Includes Senior Staff Row (cabins) Junior Staff Row ("Tebins"), and other senior staff housing.
STEM Area	Area	New area, replacing the Handicraft area. Focusing on STEM type merit badges. Such as Space Exploration, Welding and Nuclear Science.
Sunday Leader's Meeting	Activity	Introduction and information meeting held 7:00 pm Sunday in the Staff Center for Unit Leaders.
Three Islands (3-I)	Semi-Retired Term	Camp subdivision including the Trek and Outing (Trip) centers. The name is derived from three small islands in the area of the Outing (Trip) center.
Three Pound Pond	Area	Pond in the center of camp. Includes the waterfront at the eastern end and is bordered by an number of unit sites.
Trading Post	Area	Located in center of camp. Offers camp merchandise, supplies, snacks, slushies, and other assorted items.

Trailblazers	Activity & Area	First-year program focused on early rank advancement (up to first class) and patrol methods. Located next to the Waterfront on Three Pound Pond.
Trout Pond	Semi- Retired Term	Camp subdivision including the main prtion of camp (Trading Post, Waterfront, central program areas, etc.)
Virgin Timber Landing	Location	Hiking destination at west end of Lows Lake A rocker location.
Water Olympics	Activity	End of week competition at the waterfront program area.
West Gate	Location	Gate across main road located at western boundary of camp property.
