Every Scout has a Uniform! Coordinate with Scouts and Adults to wear their Uniforms on a given day, and distribute invitations to anyone interested in Scouting.

What You're Going To Need:

- Scouts & Adults in BSA Uniform
- Bring a Buddy or Business Card Sized invitations to attend Joining event.

How You're Going To Organize This:

Select a date among your families for Scouts and Leaders (where applicable) to wear their Uniforms to school or work (no more than 2 weeks before Joining Event).

Contact your District Executive with a specific request for invitations, including count, and all joining event and contact information, pick up invitations from the Scout Service Center when ready or work with your DE for delivery to an event. Best yet, if you have a specific idea, feel free to make your own!


